Czech Society for Mountain Medicine

In the period 2018-2019, as in previous years, **first aid workshops** for mountaineering instructors, members of the Czech Mountaineering Federation (CMF) were organized by the Medical Commission under Dr. Jana Kubalová's management.

<u>Mountain Medicine Courses for Mountaineers</u> led by Dr. Kristina Höschlová continued with practical modules in French Alpes (Avoriaz), [<u>video</u>], and for the next year the <u>3rd International Mountain Medicine</u> <u>Course in the Czech Republic 2020</u> for medical doctors, students and paramedics is prepared.

Czech Mountain Medicine Conference 2018 – <u>The 29th Pelikán's seminar "Medical Aspects in Mountaineering 2018 (report in English)"</u> with over 20 lectures and workshops took place in North Bohemia and the <u>30th Pelikán's seminar "Medical Aspects in Mountaineering 2019</u> will take place at 25.-27. October 2019 in North Moravia.

Dr. Jan Pala Ph.D. and Dr. Lenka Horáková took part in **International Snow Science Workshop 2018 in Innsbruck.** Dr. Lenka Horáková presented there her research "<u>Monitoring of subjects during avalanche snow experiments: possible errors</u>". Dr. Hana Kubinová, Dr. Jana Kubalová, Martin Honzík DiS, and Mgr. Ivana Sikulová Ph.D. attended **ICAR Convention Chamonix 2018.**

Dr. Kristina Höschlová (abstracts *Are the Eight-Thousanders Prone to Become Mentally Retarded?, Are Trips to High Altitude Beneficial for Psychiatric Patients?*), Dr. Jana Kubalová (abstract *Malenák & Kubalová: The EMS Mobile App)*, and Dr. Hana Kubinová visited the **XII ISMM World Congress on Mountain Medicine 21.-24. 11. 2018 in Kathmandu**. Dr. Höschlová published a lecture on *High altitude Illness* held at the 11th Congress of Primary Care in Prag in 2017 and had two presentations (*Management of Hemorrhagic Shock in a War Trauma Centre, Trauma Management in Difficult Mountain Environment*) at the International Mediterranean Emergency Medicine Congress in Dubrovnik on Sept 23, 2019.

Society and Medical Commission members published several articles on health problems of mountaineering and mountain medicine, I personally (with Dr. Novák, Ph.D.) three articles for the **Czech Society of Sports Medicine Bulletin "Medicina Sportiva Bohemica & Slovaca"** on 40th Mount Everest Ascent Anniversary w/o oxygen, the first Czech expedition medical doctor MUDr. Jaromír Wolf (UIAA Vice-President emeritus was born 100 years ago [link], and Sir Edmund Hillary was born 100 years ago; also on the web site. We remind Medicina in Montana — UIAA congress on mountain medicine in 1983 In Maloja.

Our Society website <u>www.horska-medicina.cz</u> is supplemented by unpublished posts, congress reports, mountain medicine and mountaineering book lists, bibliography, as well as latest news. Czech Societies for Diabetology and Internal Diseases have been informed about the <u>UIAA Medical Commission</u> <u>Recommendations for Mountaineers, Hillwalkers, Trekkers, and Rock and Ice Climbers with Diabetes 2018</u>.

I am very sorry I have to excuse myself from this year meeting. My colleague Dr. Lenka Horáková, the President of the Czech Society for Mountain Medicine will attend the annual meeting instead of me.
